

Medicare Fraud Alert

New Medicare Cards Arriving in 2018

- New Medicare cards will be mailed April 2018 through April 2019
- New Medicare number will not be tied to anyone's Social Security number
- There is NO CHARGE for new cards and Medicare will NEVER call for information
- Scammers are calling and claiming to be from Medicare. They have various lines such as they must confirm the Medicare number before sending a new card. FALSE! MEDICARE WILL NOT CALL.

People will continue to try and steal your new Medicare number, but they'll never be able to steal your full identity with it again. Always read your Medicare Summary Notice to make sure no one is billing for services in your name.
